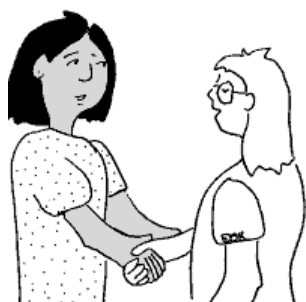


CALL supporting people living with cancer

By arranging social activities, like days out and coffee mornings

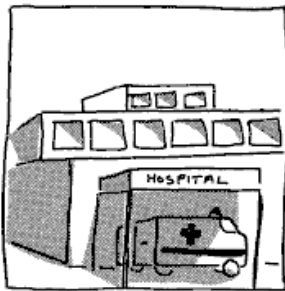




By helping in other ways, like with shopping

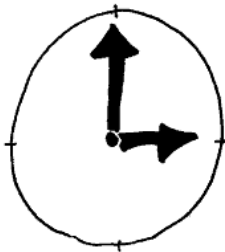

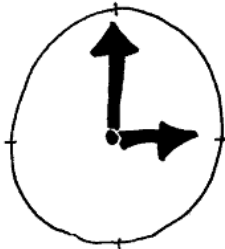
